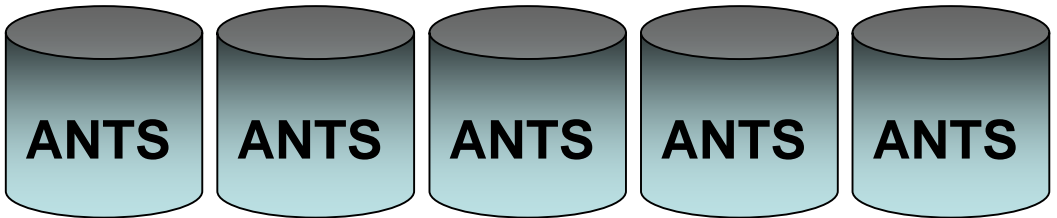
Adam the Anteater loved his ants.



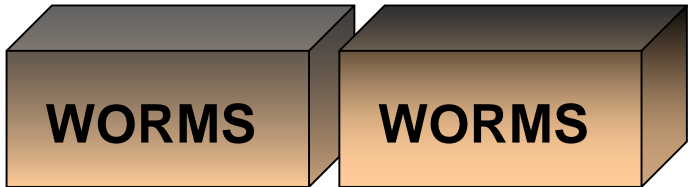

He would eat them at night when there is nothing to see.



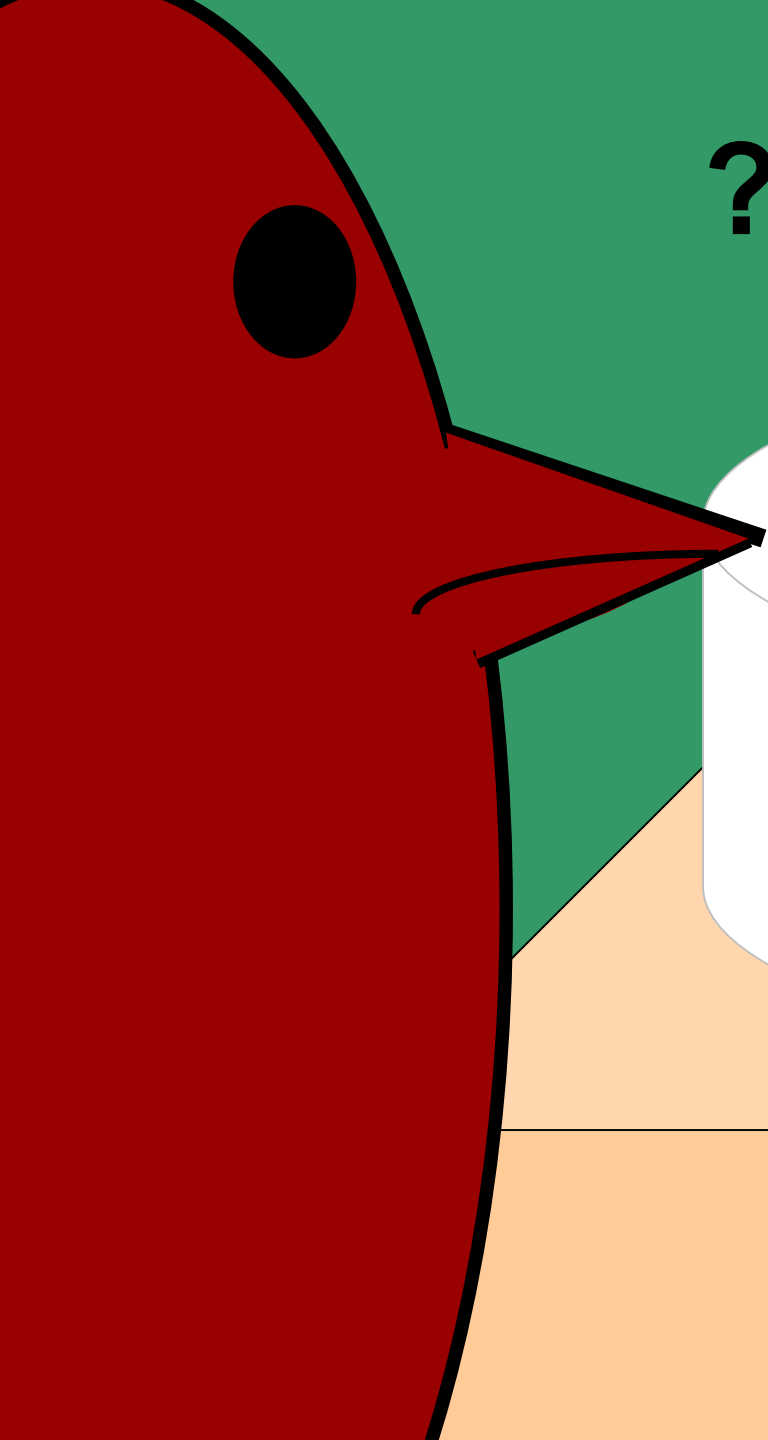
One day Adam heard something strange.

“Please don’t eat me!” cried out a voice.

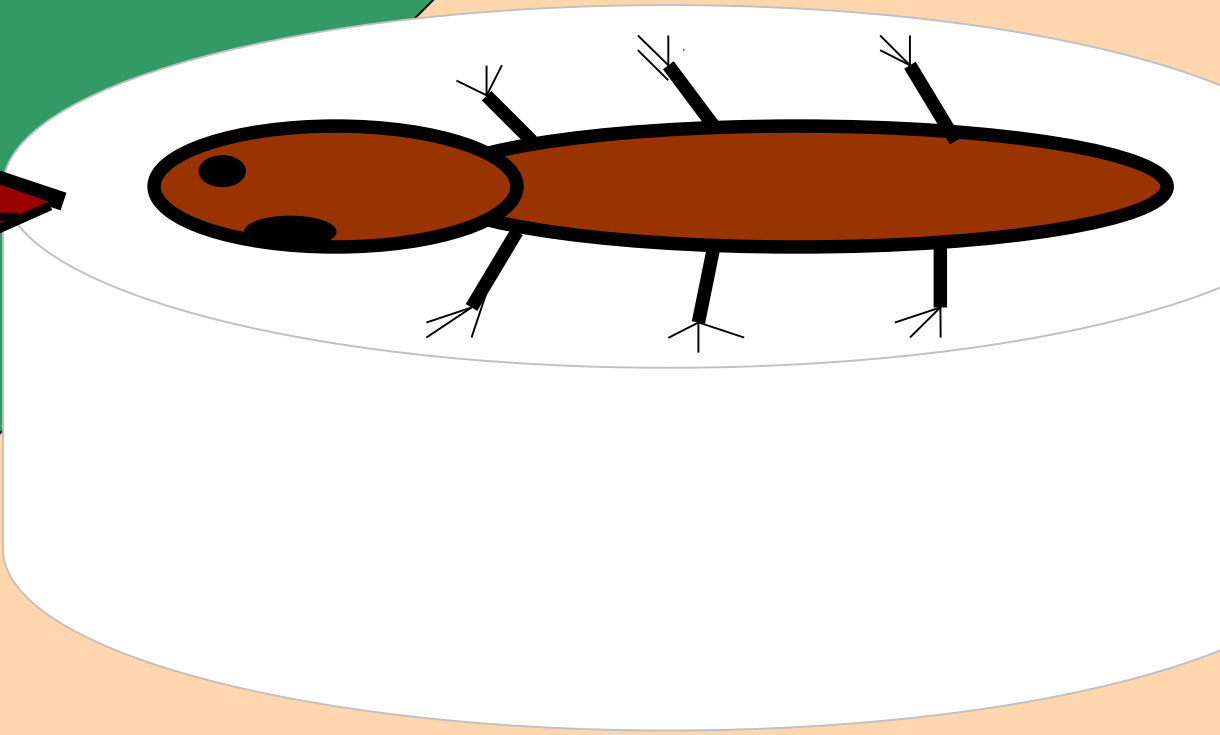
“Who is speaking?” replied Adam.

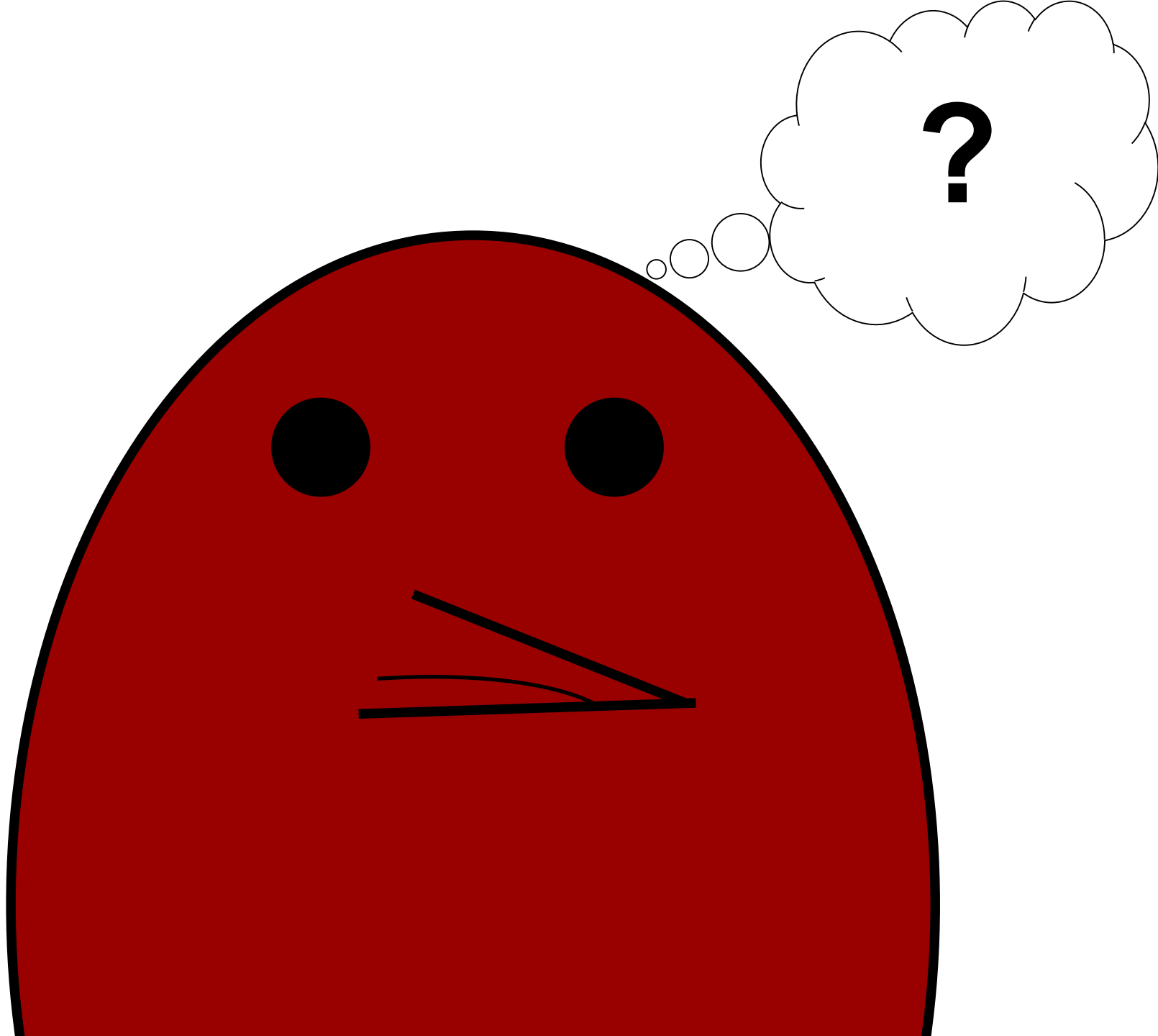


Adam was dumbfounded.

Adam needed to eat ants, so he could remain healthy.

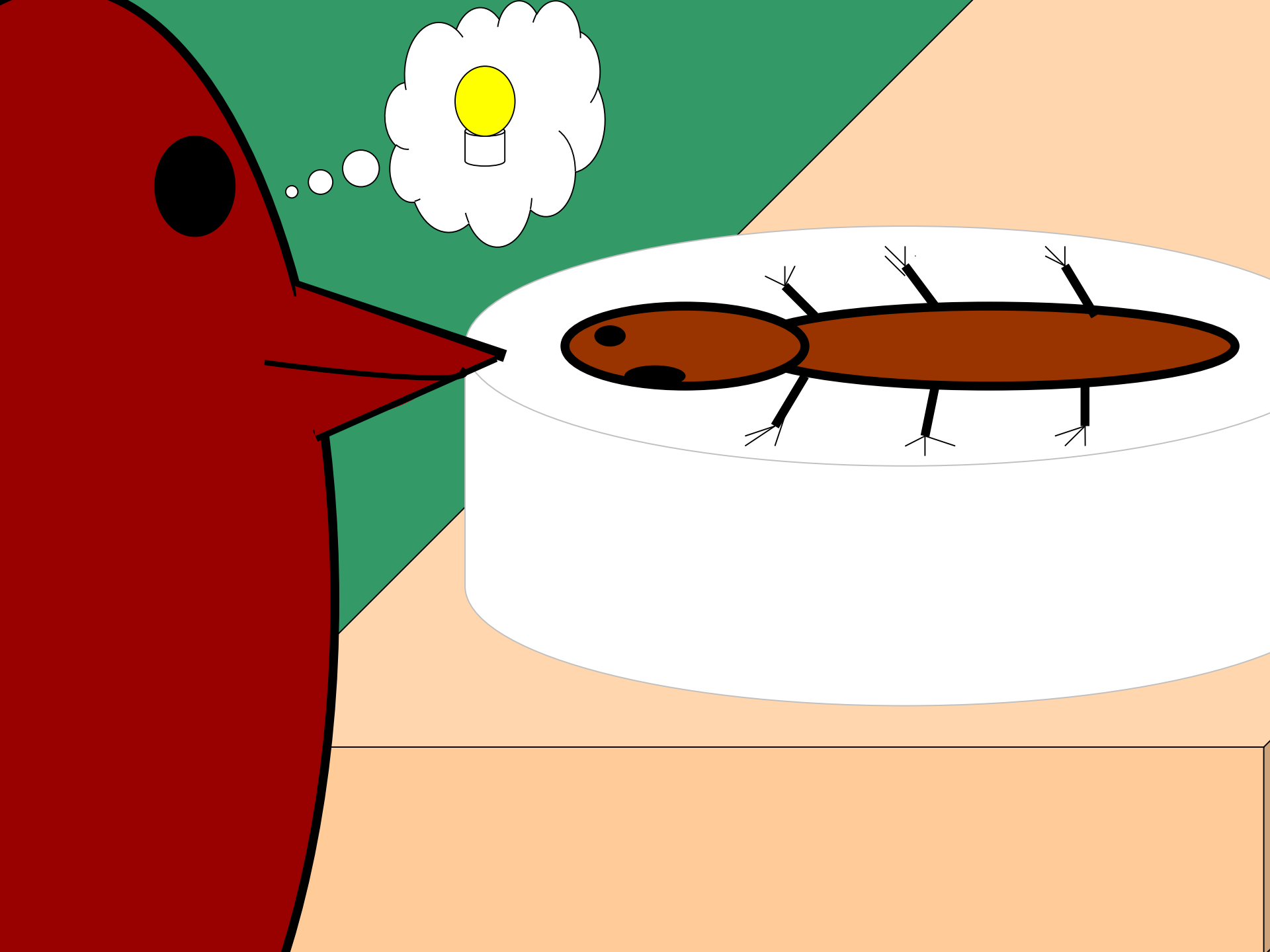
What was he going to do?

Then suddenly, an idea popped up in Adams brain.

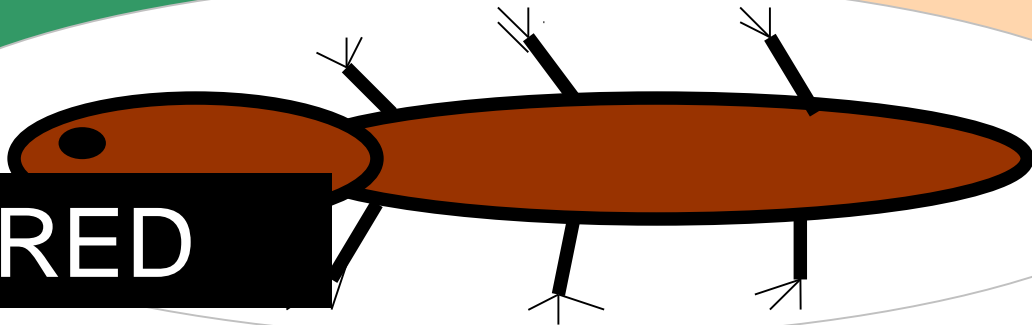


“I have an idea Andre.” said Adam.

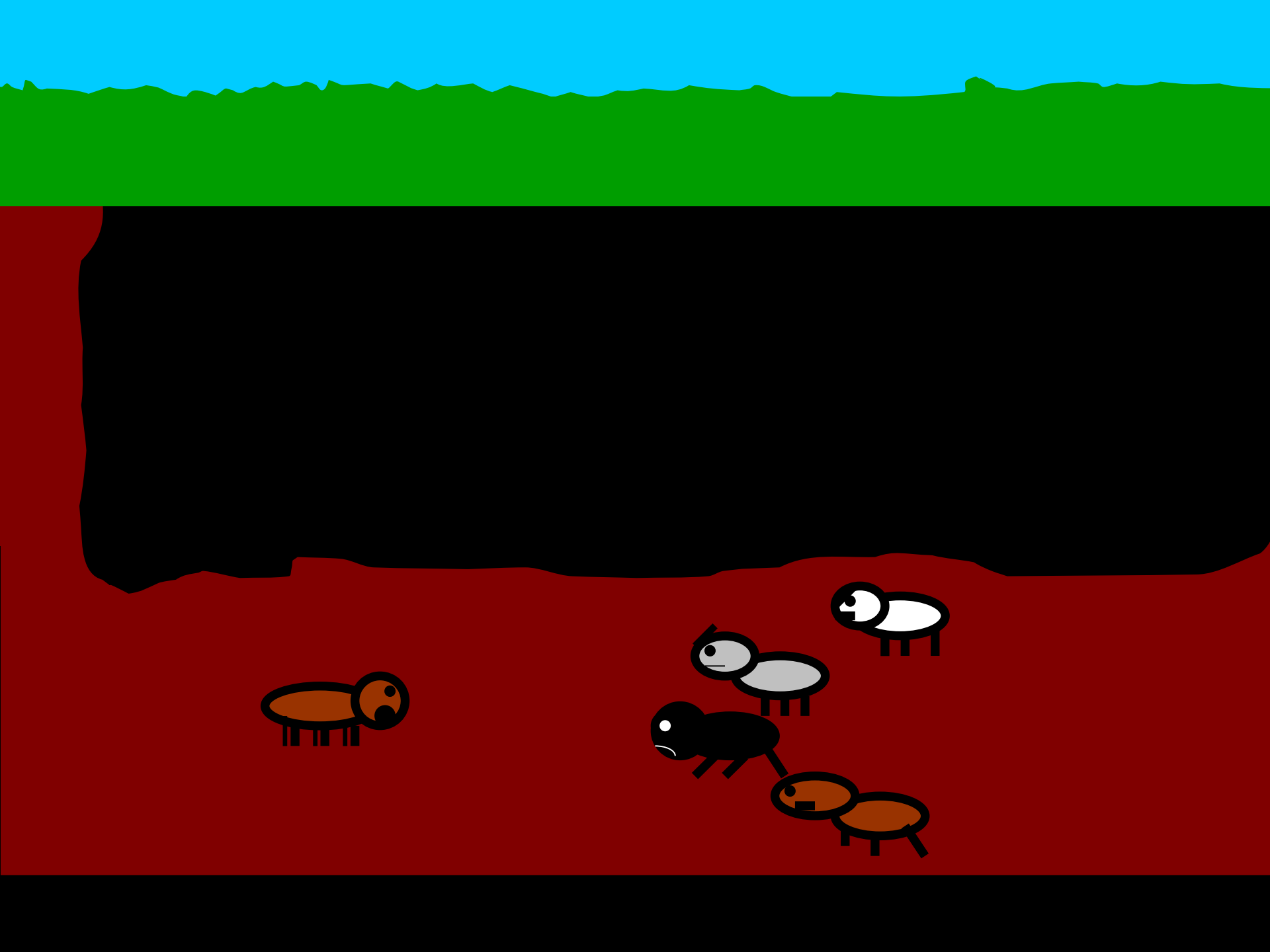
The next day Andre went to his old ant colony to see the big bad ants.

“To fight all of you big bad ugly ants outside.” said Andre.



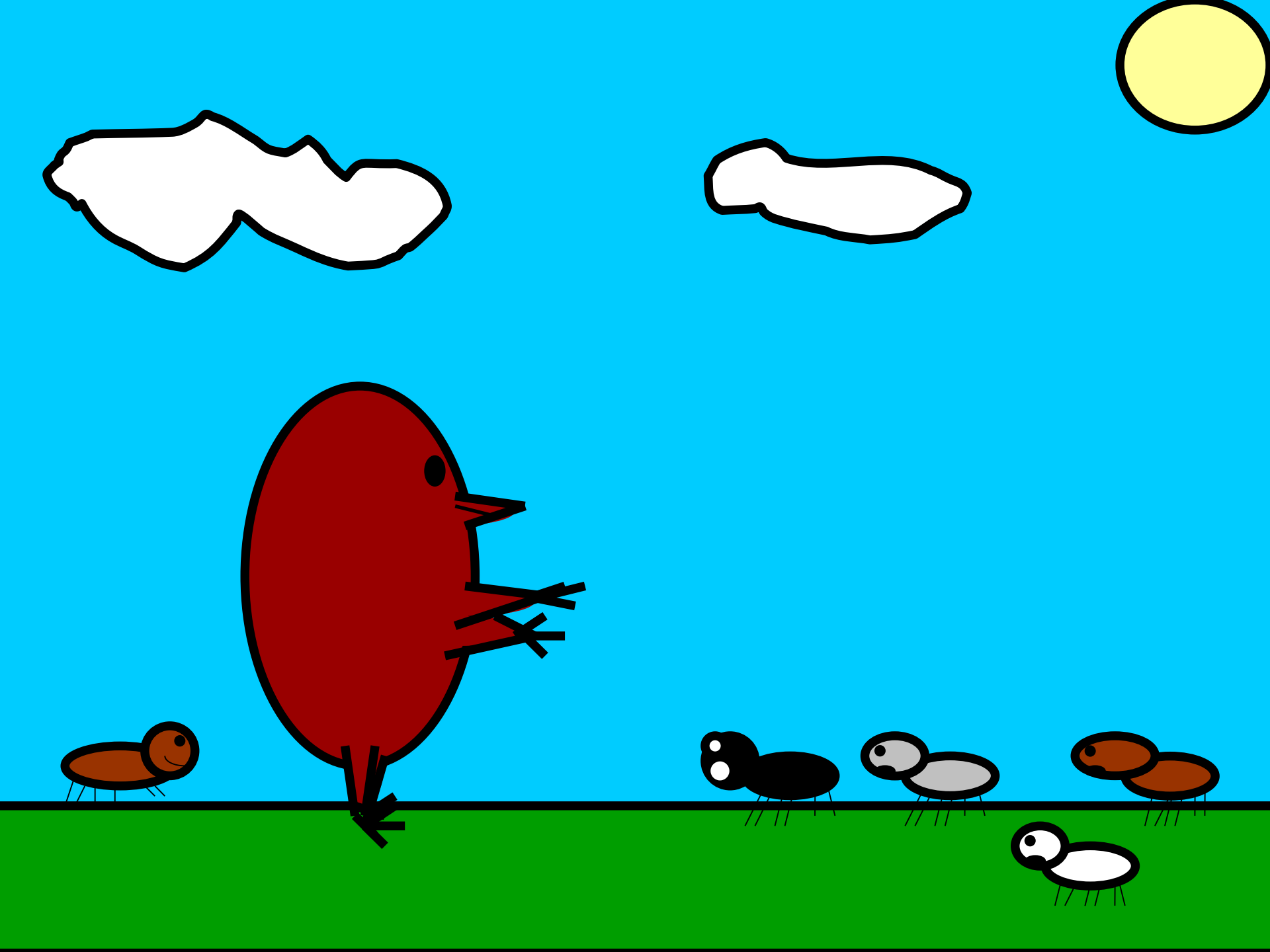


The big bad ants didn't like being called ugly, so they started to chase Andre.

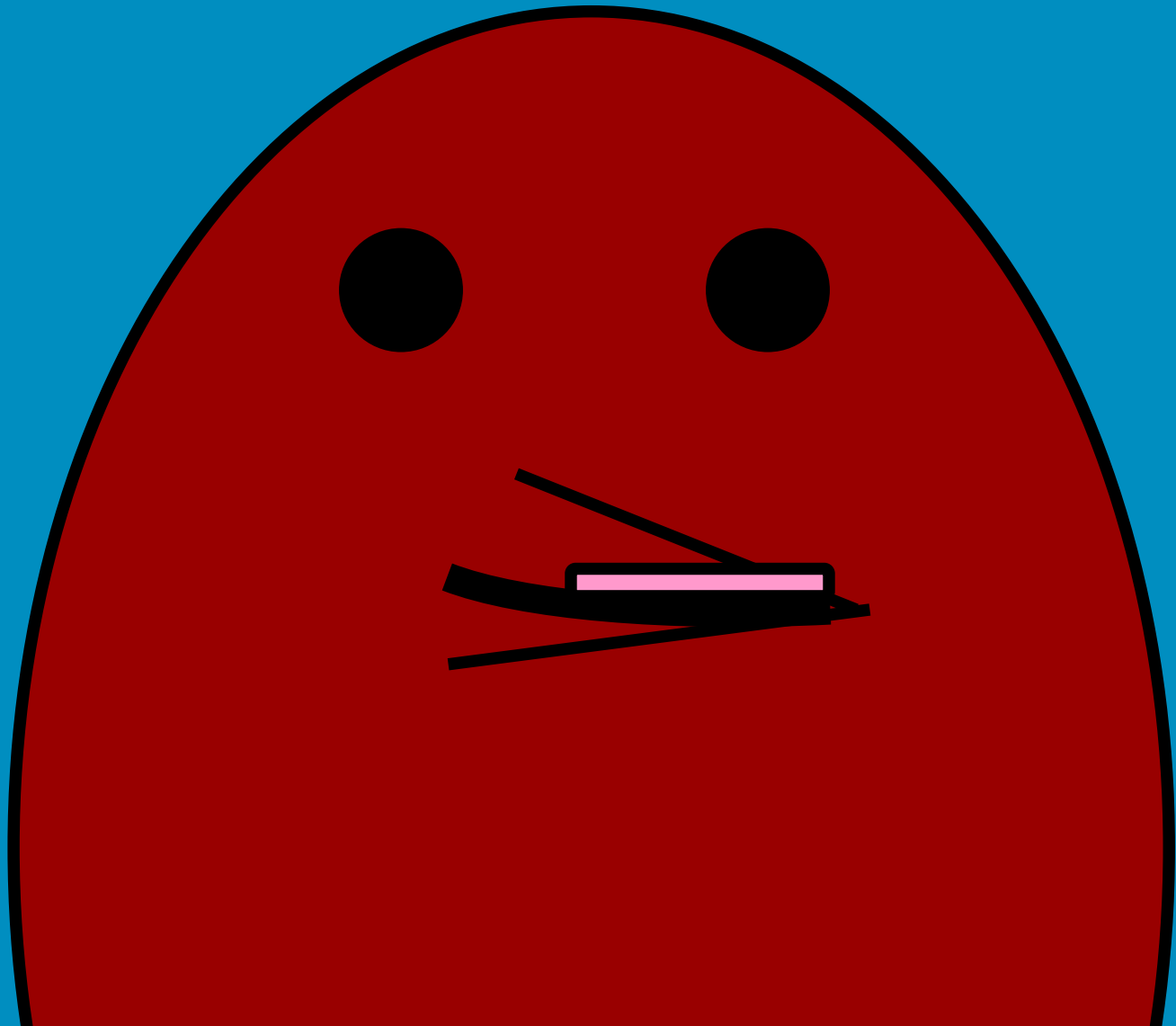
Andre ran out of the ant colony and so did the big bad bully ants...

**“RUN FOR YOUR LIVES!!!”** shouted one of the bully ants.



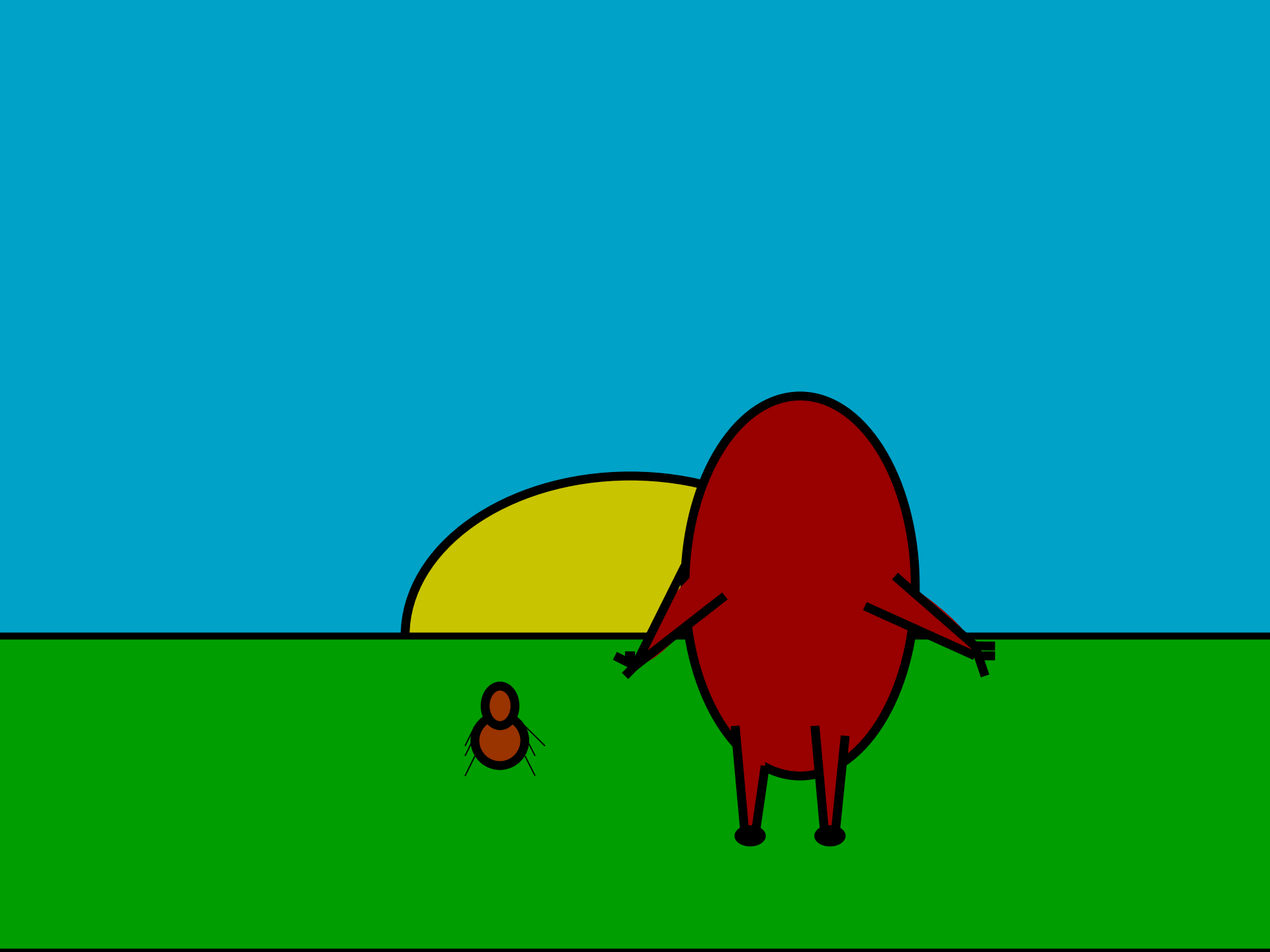
It was all too late for the big bad ants.
