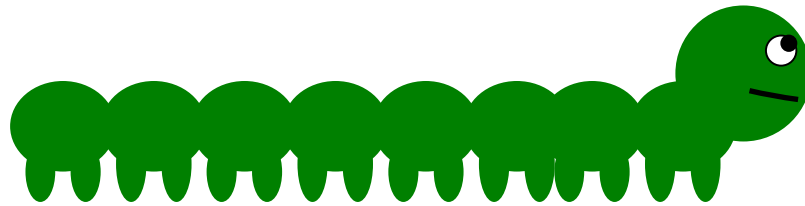
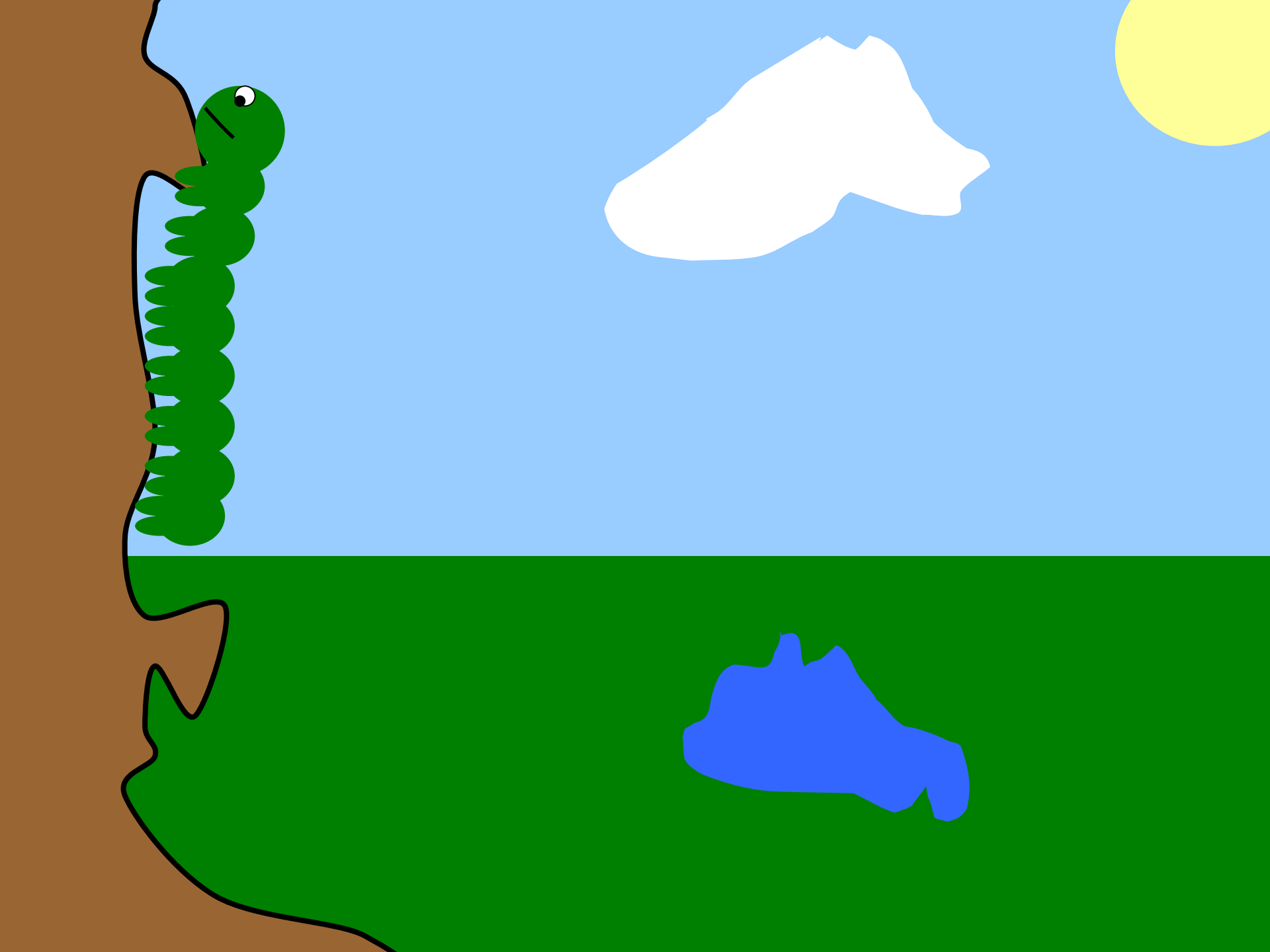


Cathy the Caterpillar

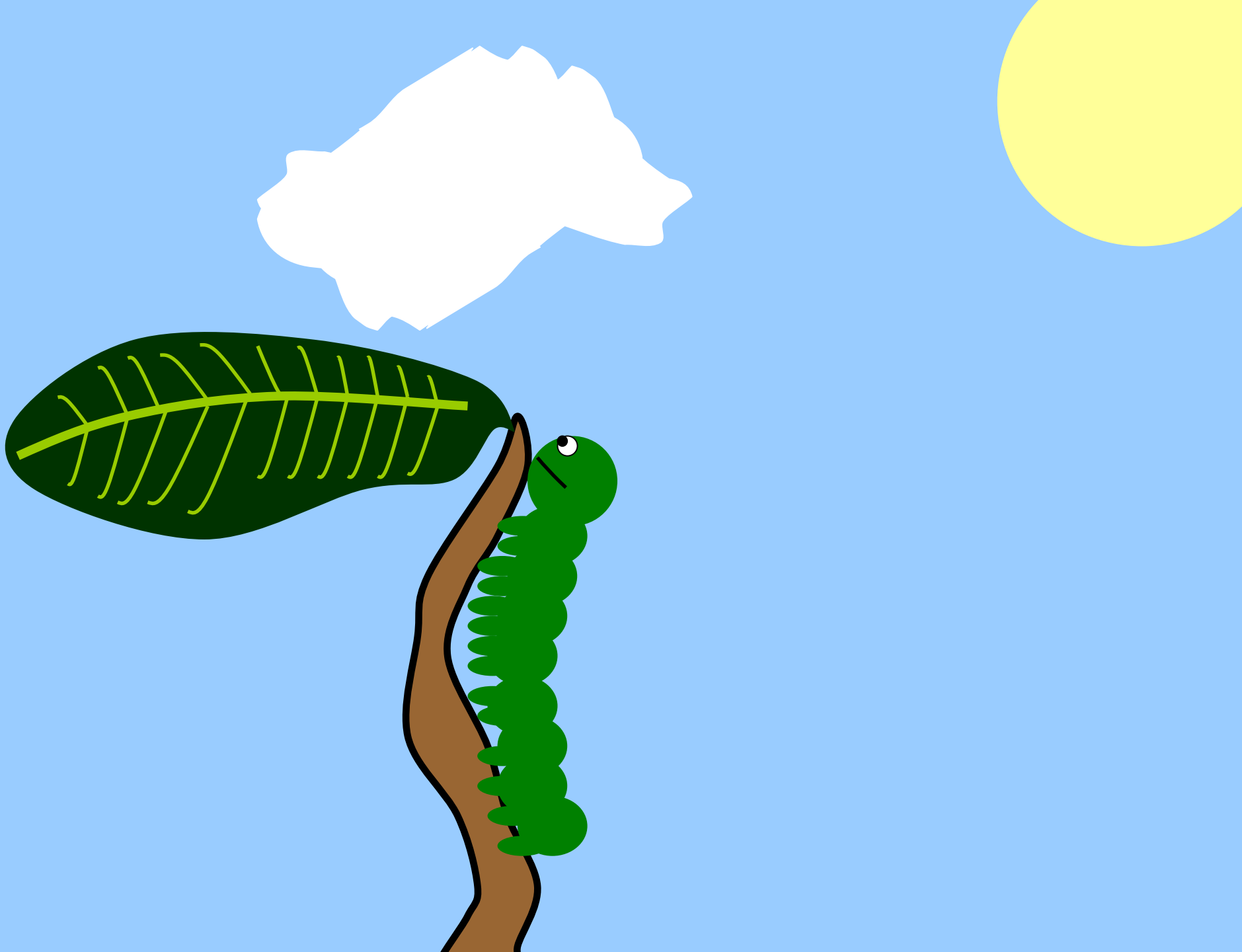

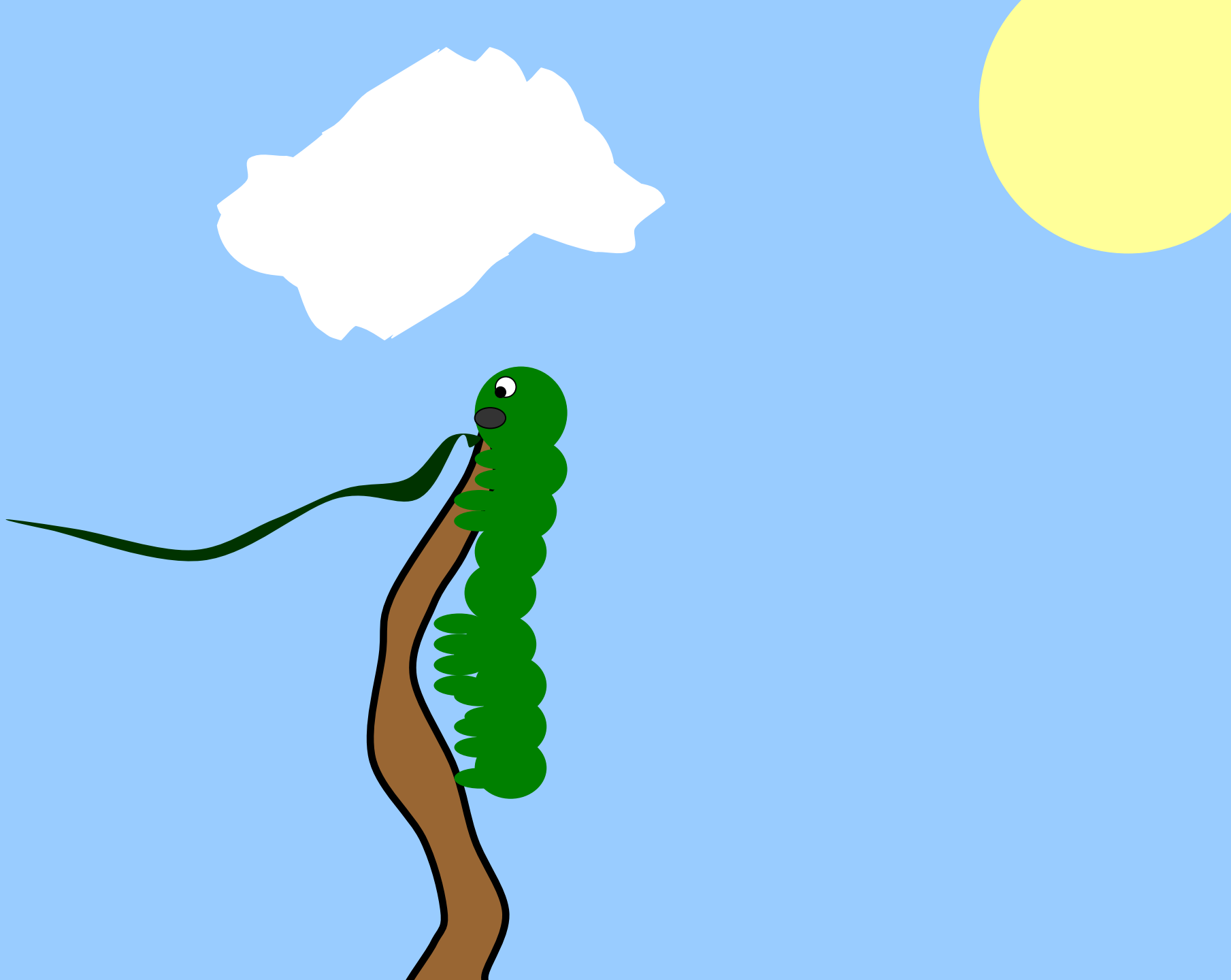
Cathy the caterpillar climbed up the crooked tree.

a nice big juicy leaf.



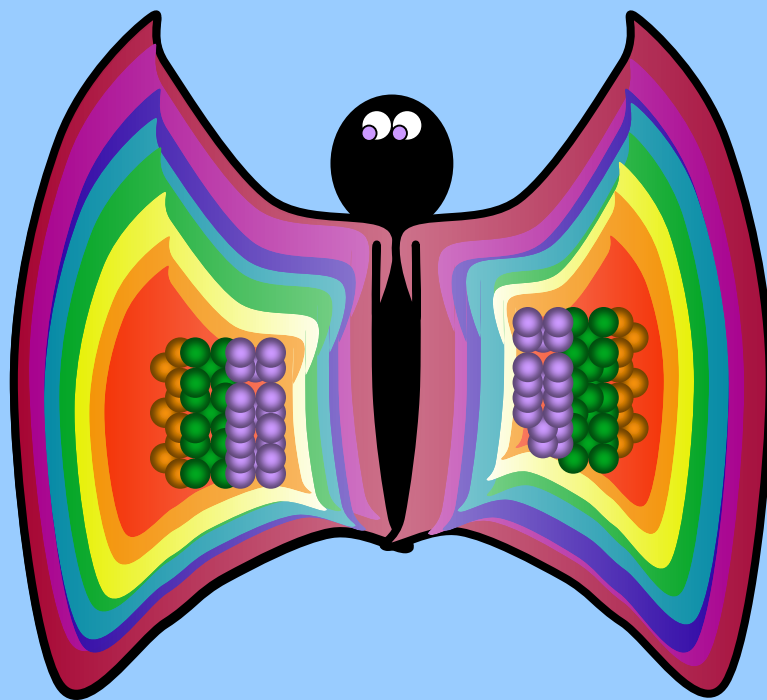
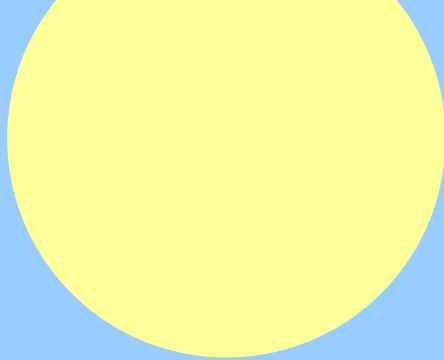
For hours and hours Cathy slowly
