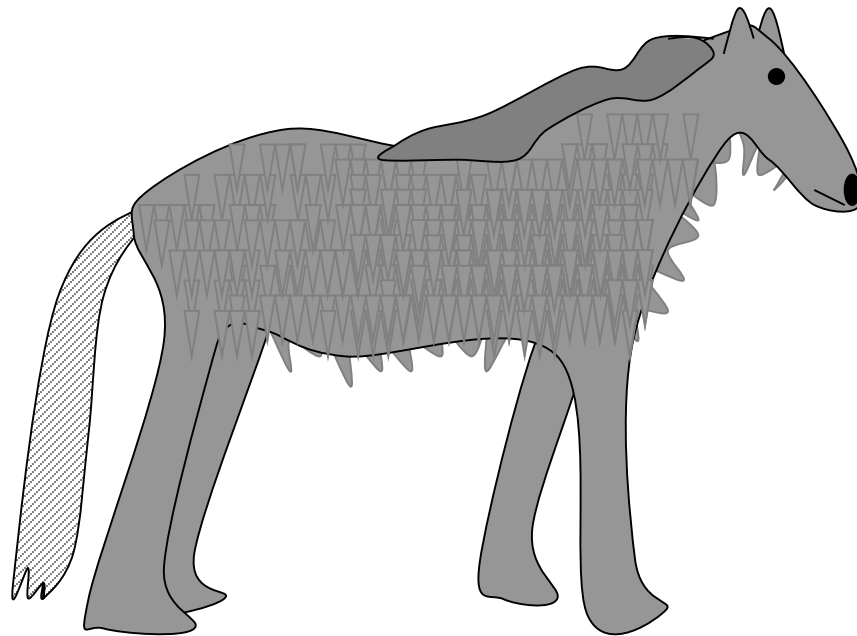
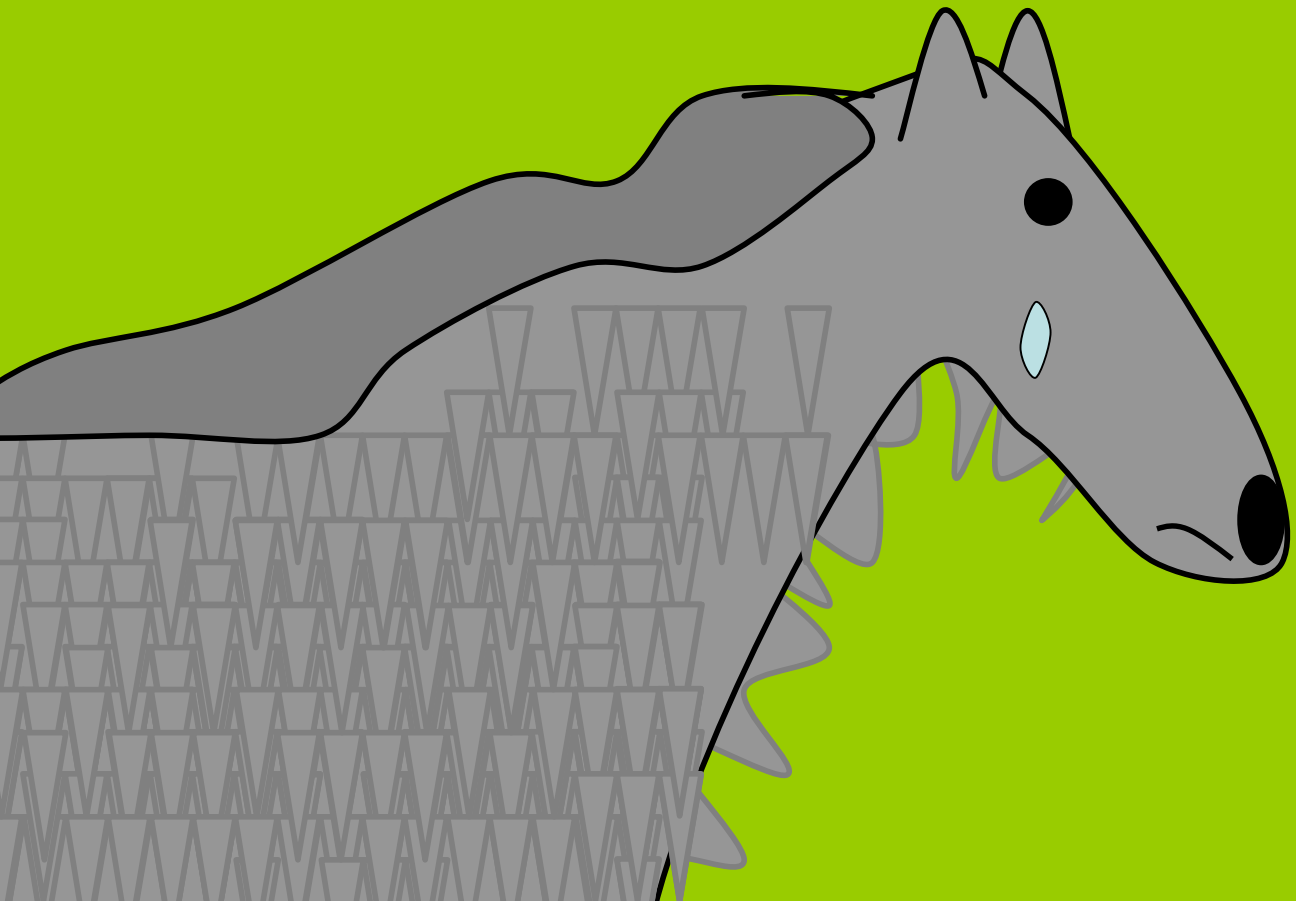


# Henry the Hairy Horse

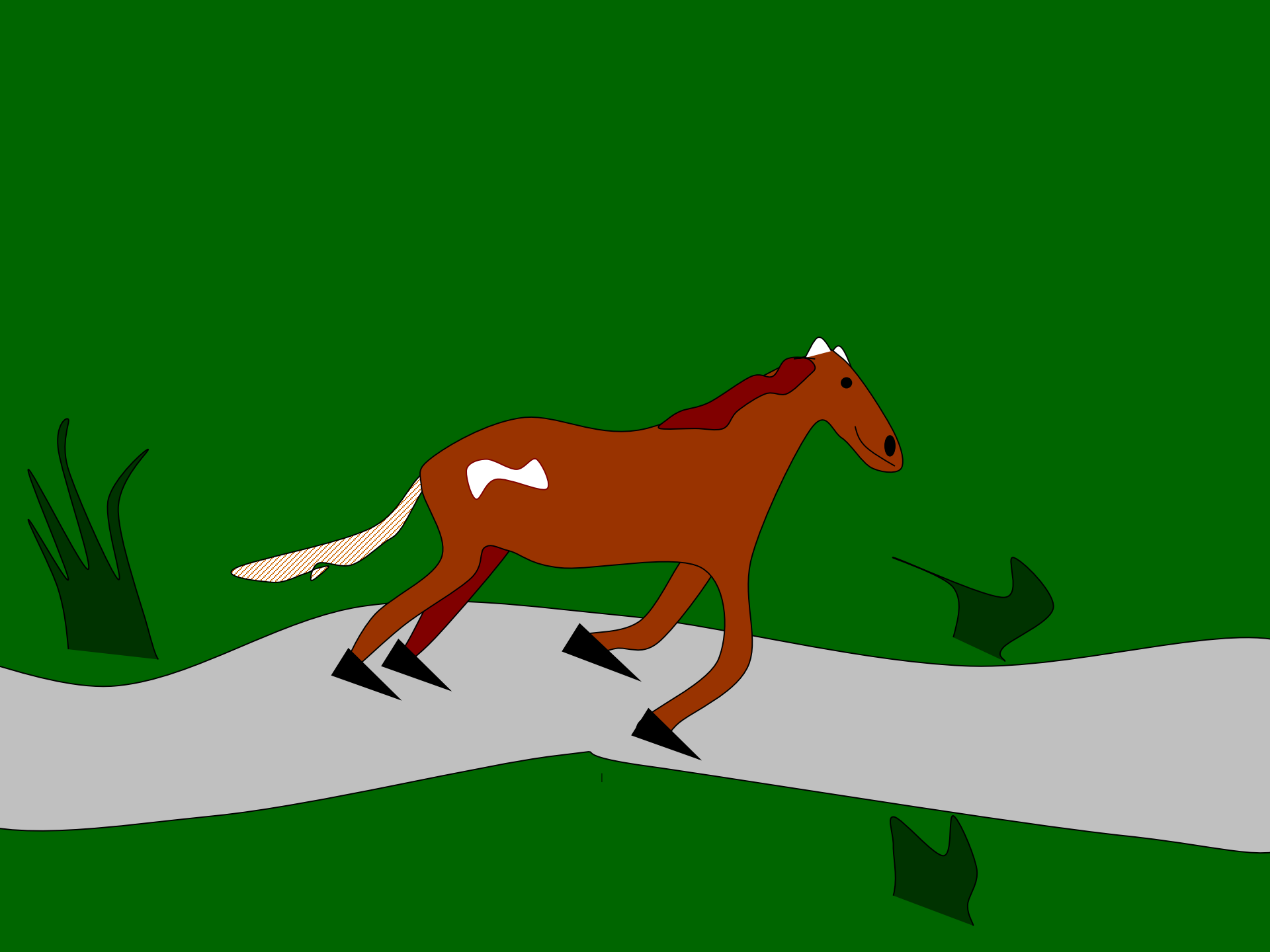

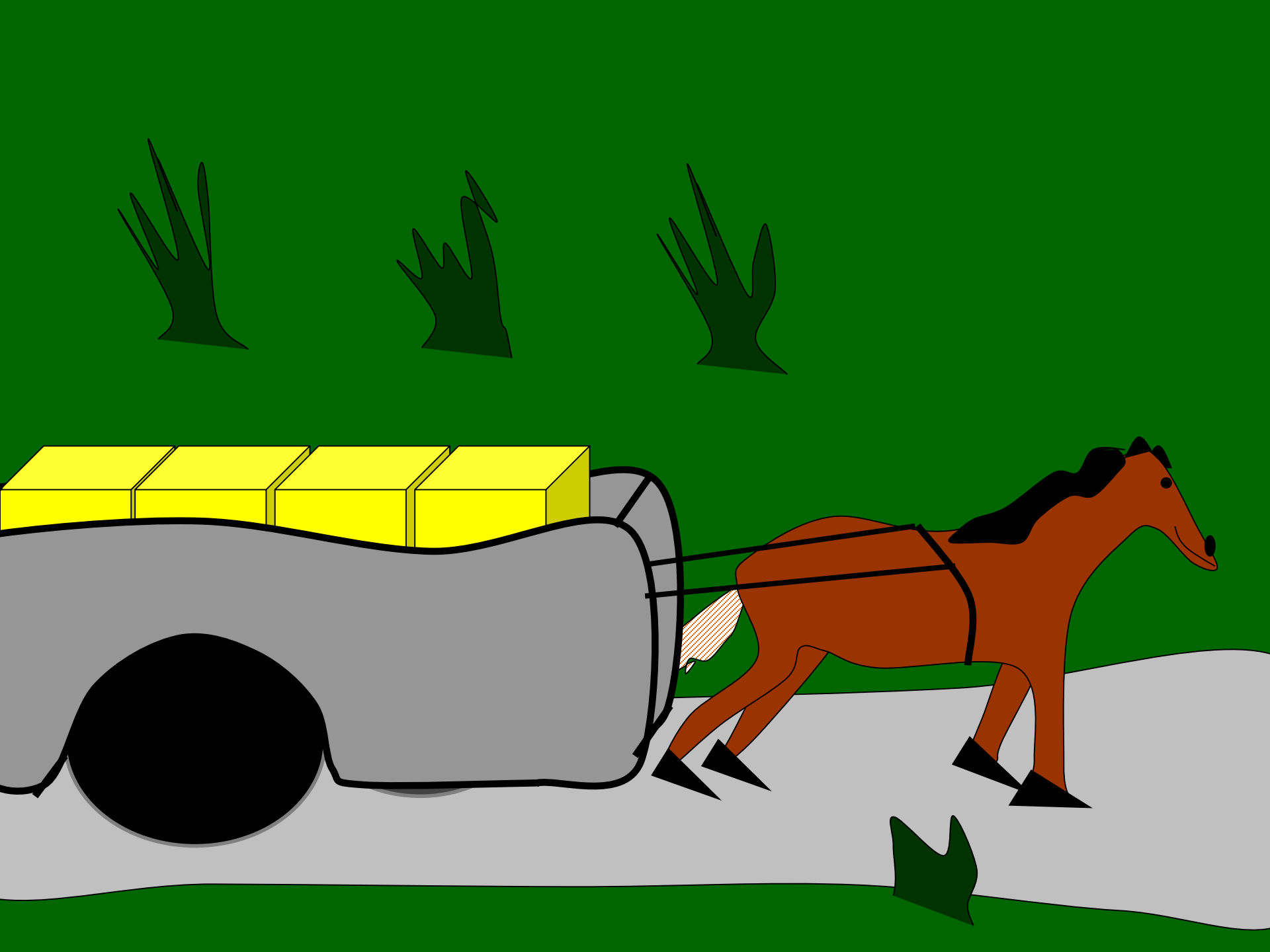
Henry is feeling a little sad

He is not the fastest horse in the paddock. Harvey is the fastest horse in the paddock.

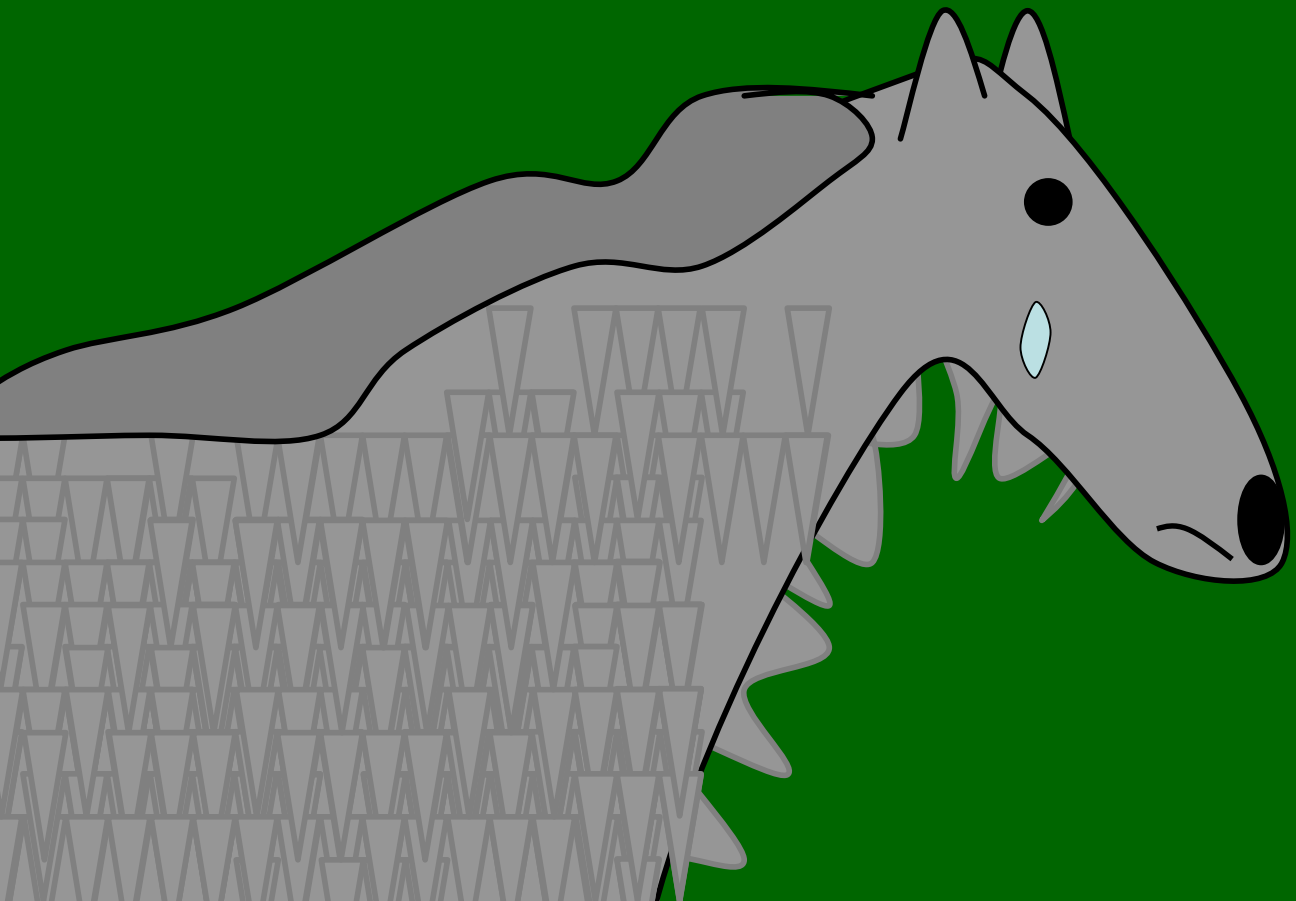


Henry is not the strongest horse in the paddock. Haneef is the strongest horse in the paddock.

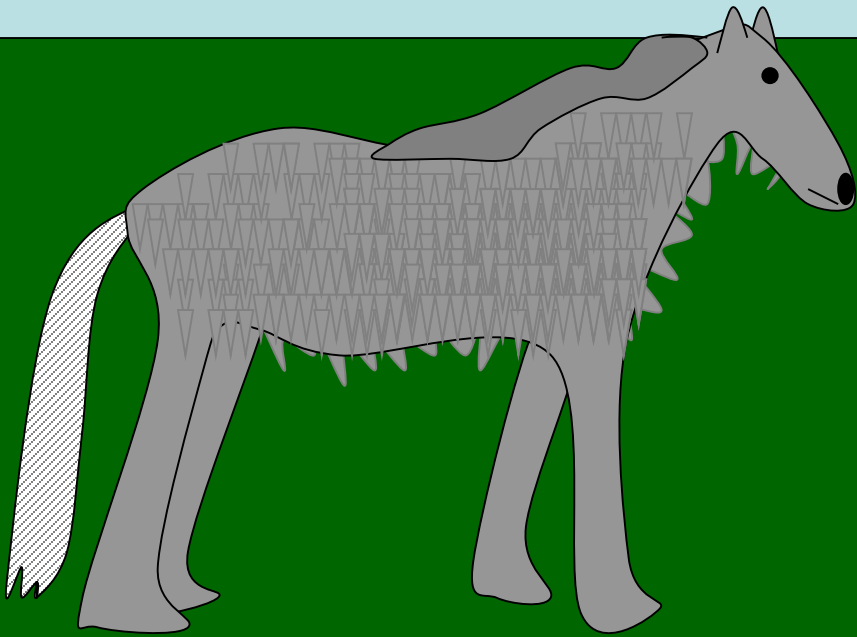
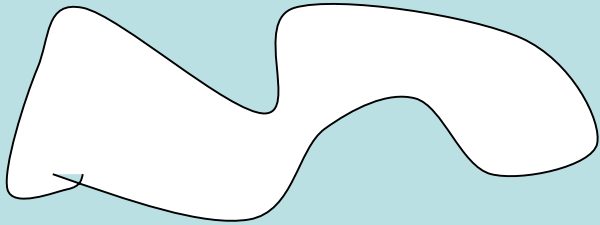


Henry is the hairiest horse in the paddock.

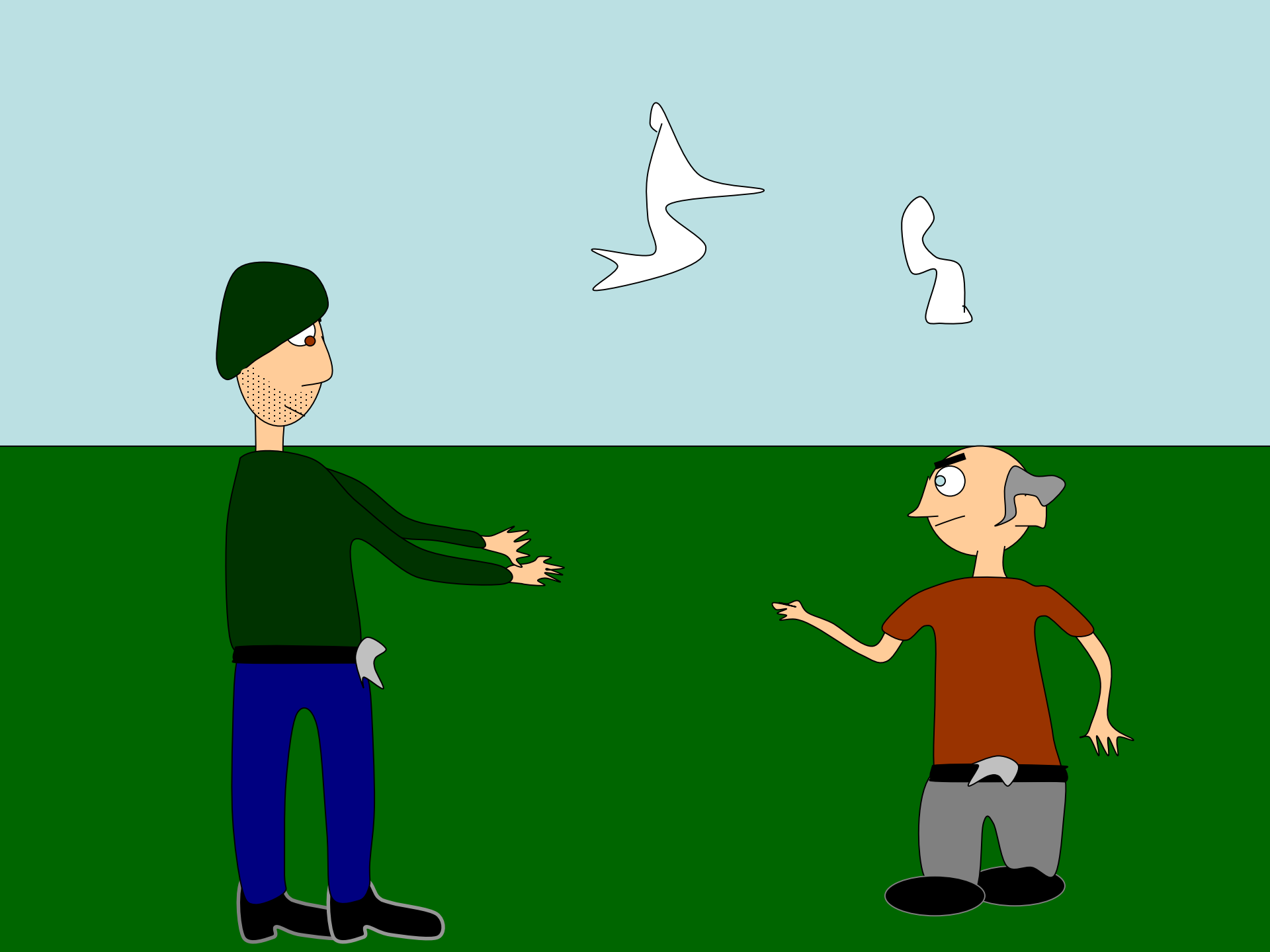




What made Henry sad is that paddock owner Grandpa Joe thinks that hairy horses are ugly and stupid. Grandpa Joe doesn't like things which are different.

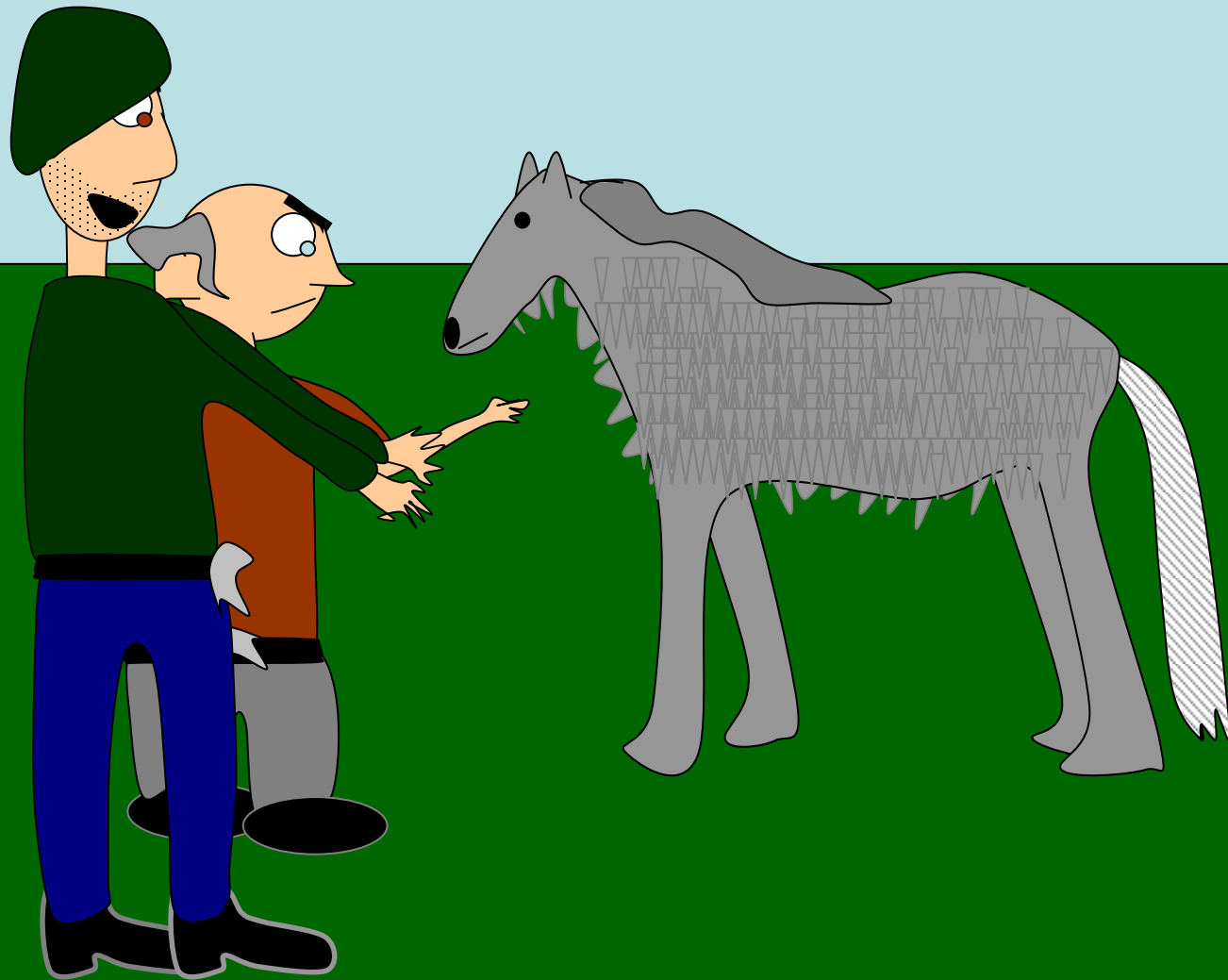


One day Grandpa Joe's

the paddock.



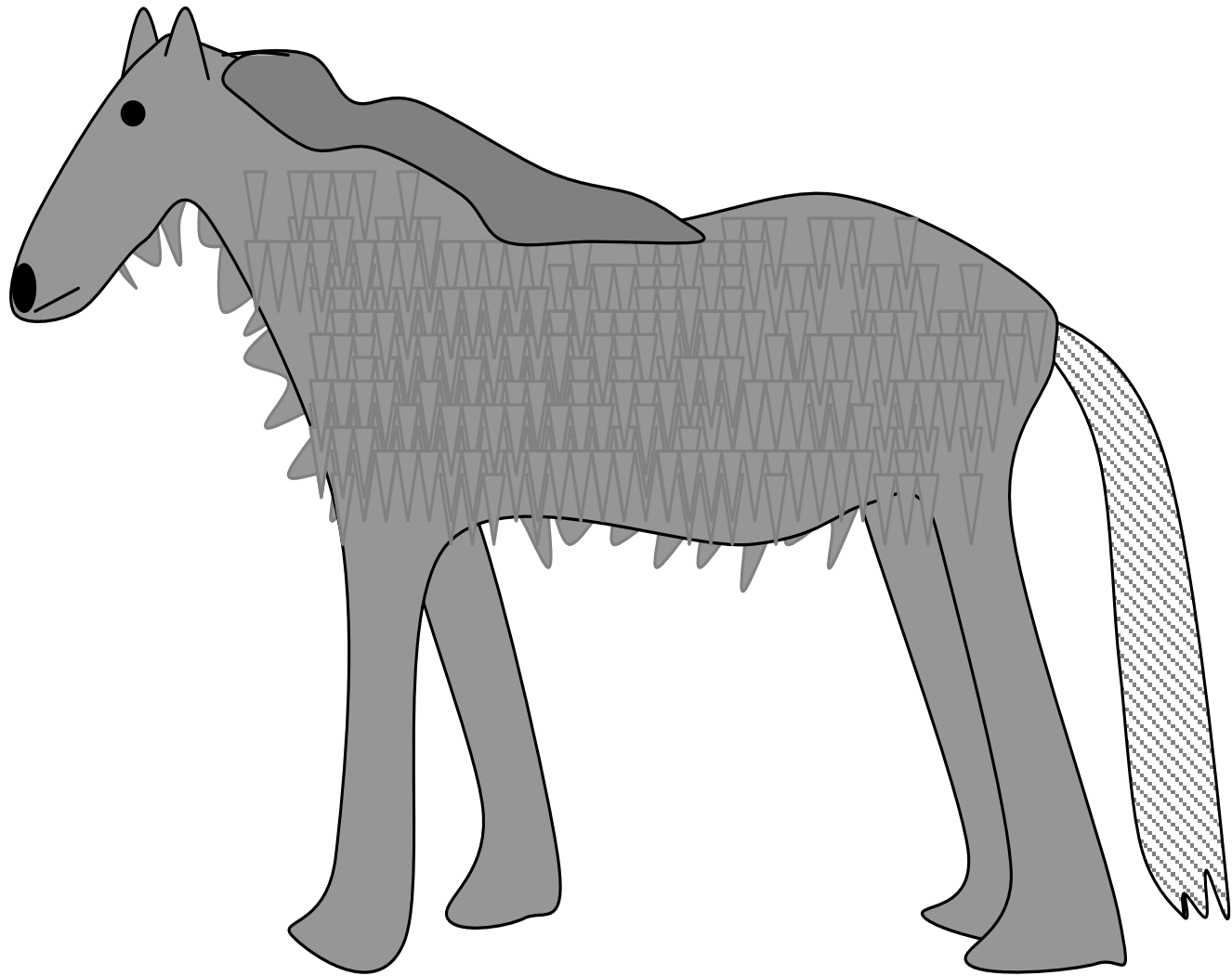
Dan Rodgers looked at Henry

ugly hairy horse with you Dan.”



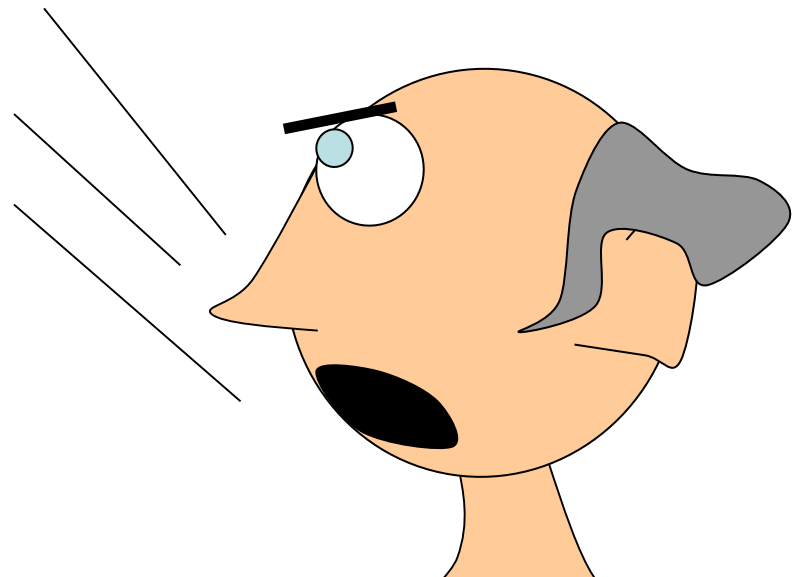
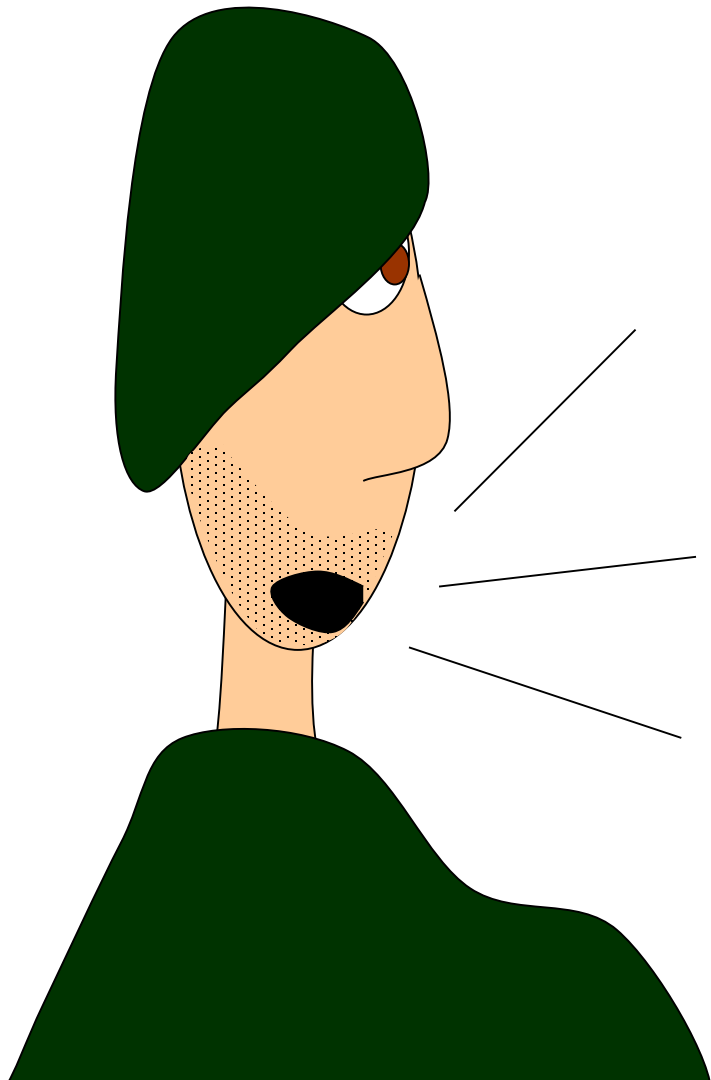


“He is not a ugly horse

“Is not”

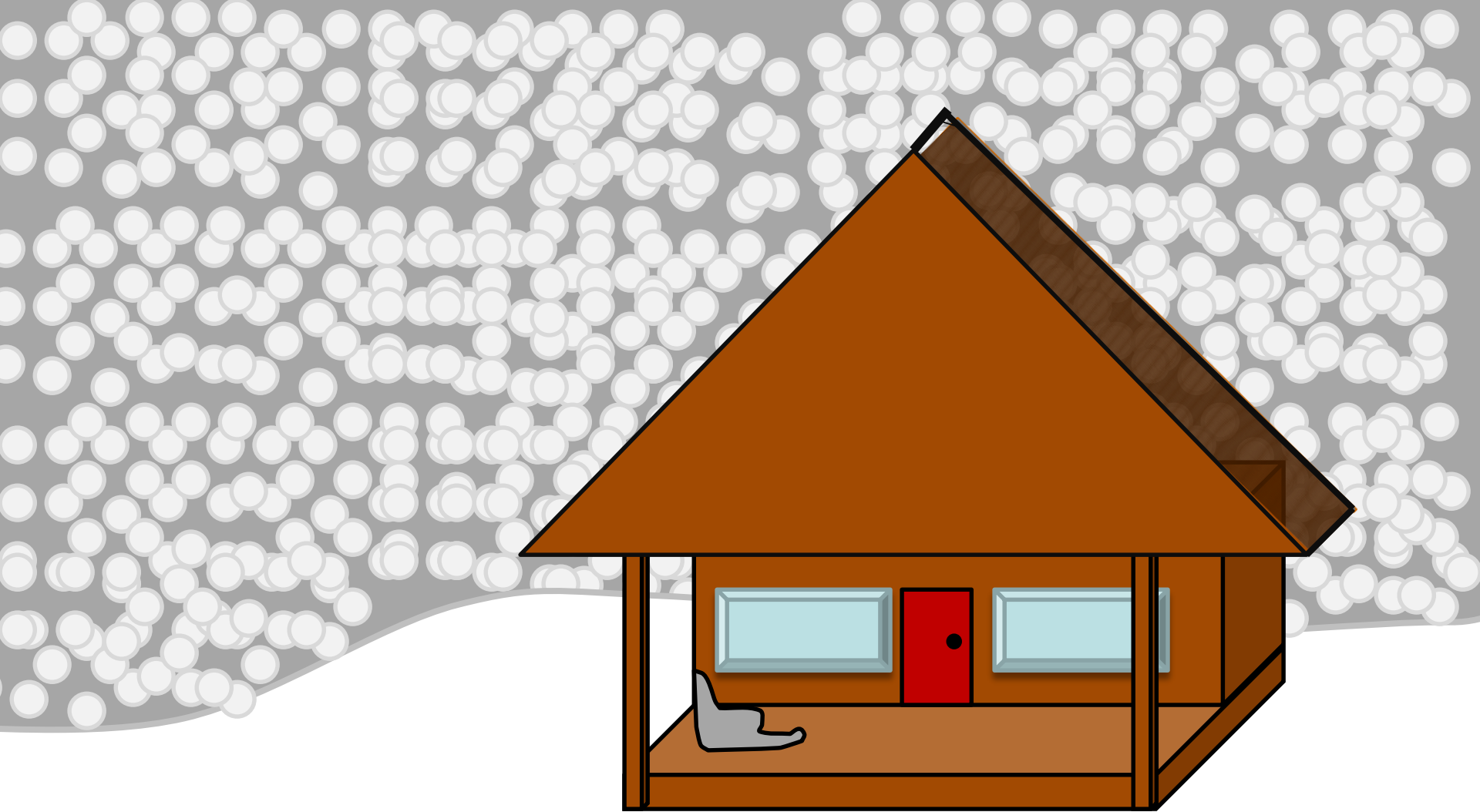
“Is too”



Dan didn't want to argue with his grandfather so he took Henry with him to his paddock.

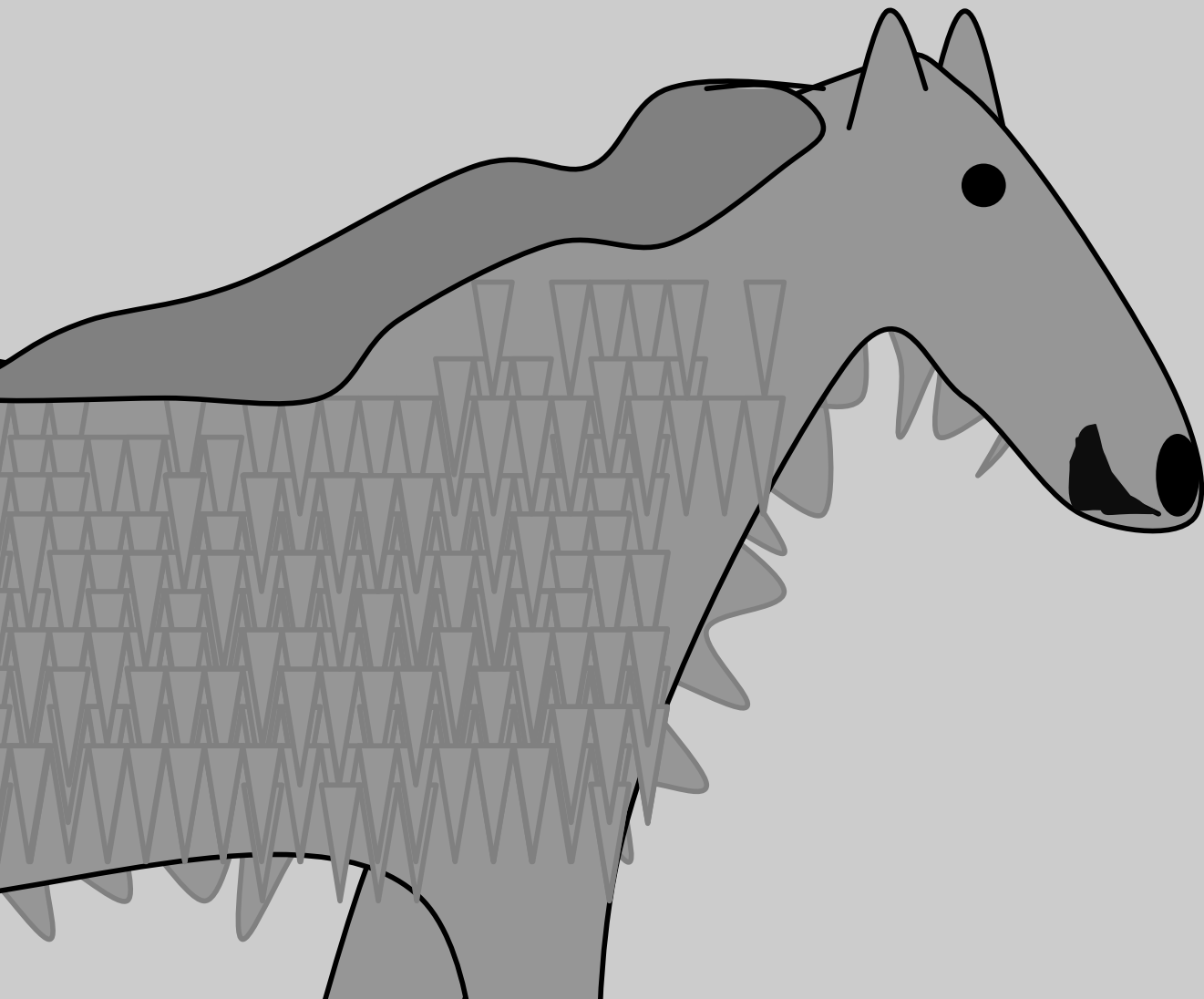


Dan Rodgers lived in a place perfect for hairy horses. It snowed, but Henry's hair would keep him nice and warm.
