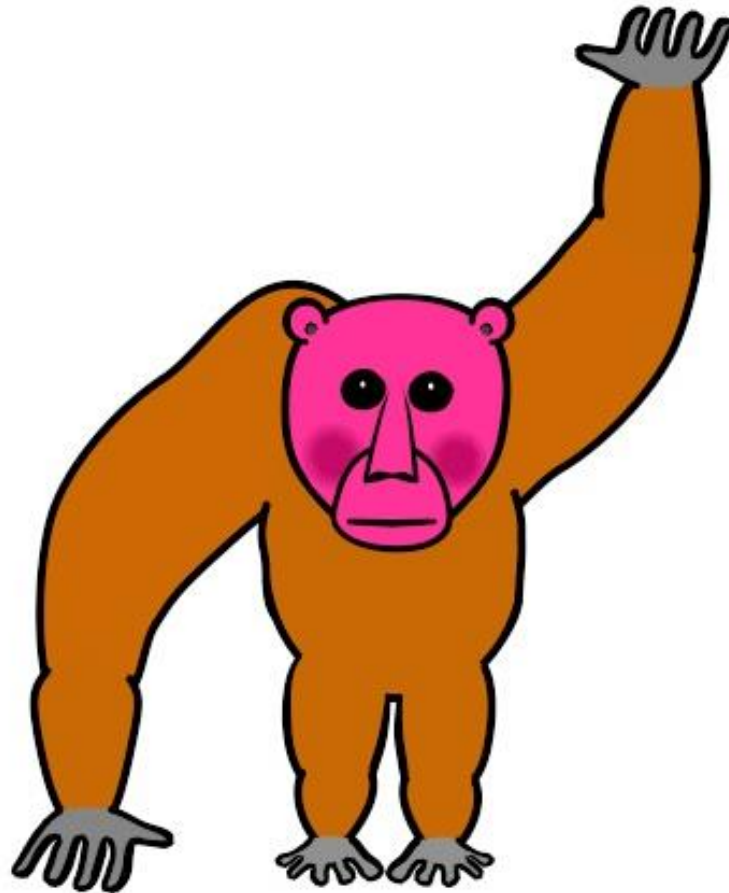
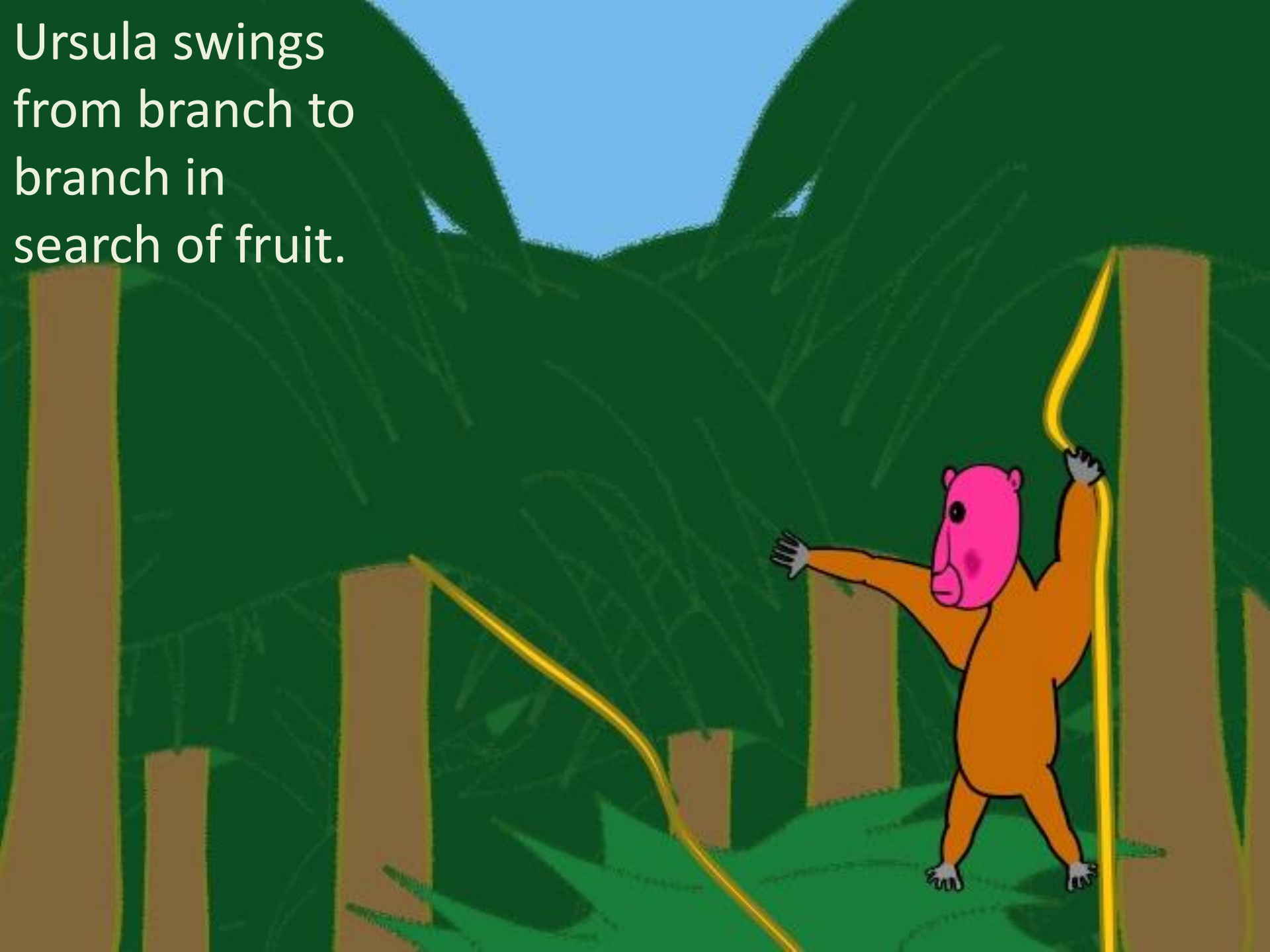


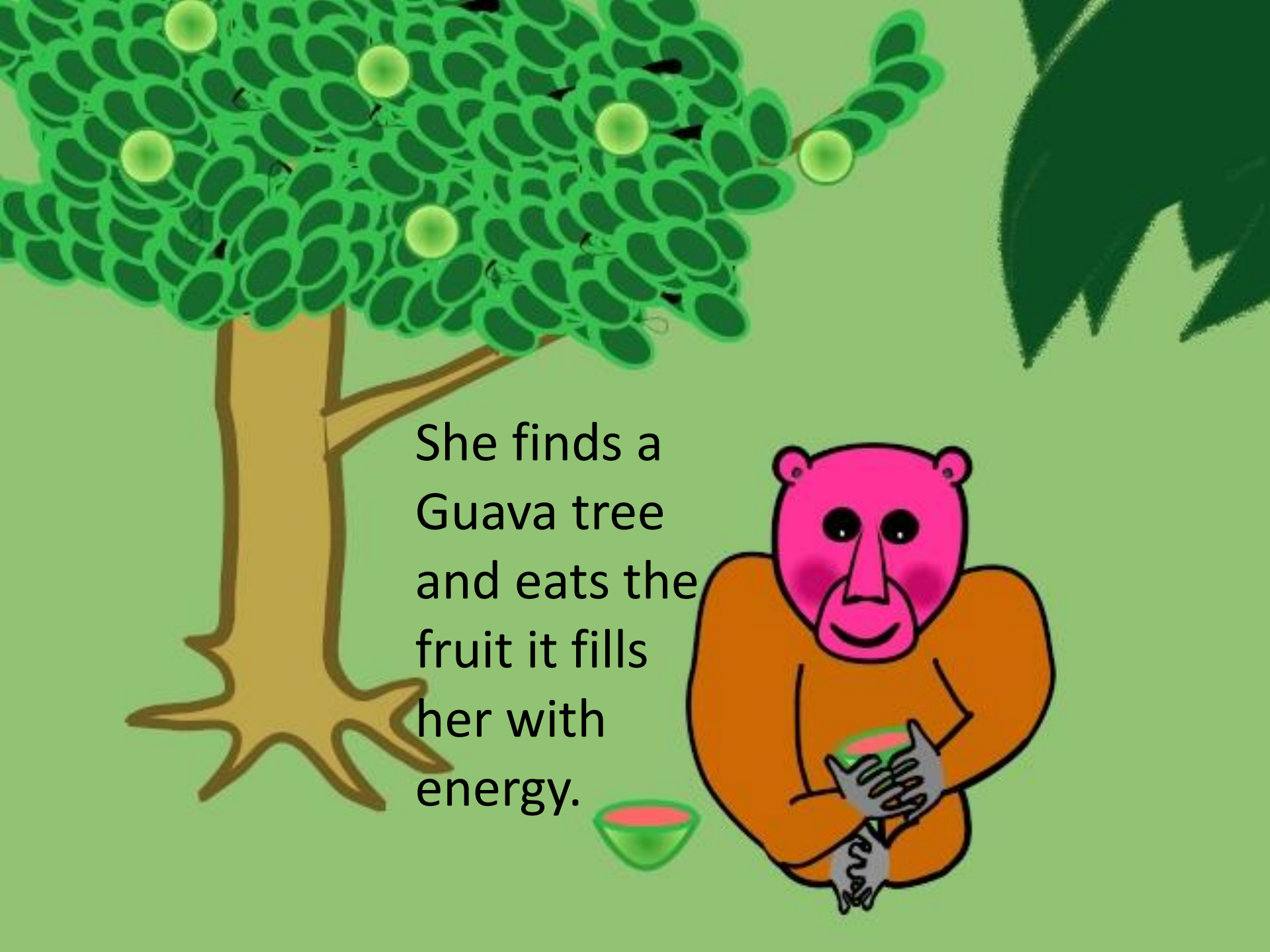
# Ursula the Uakari

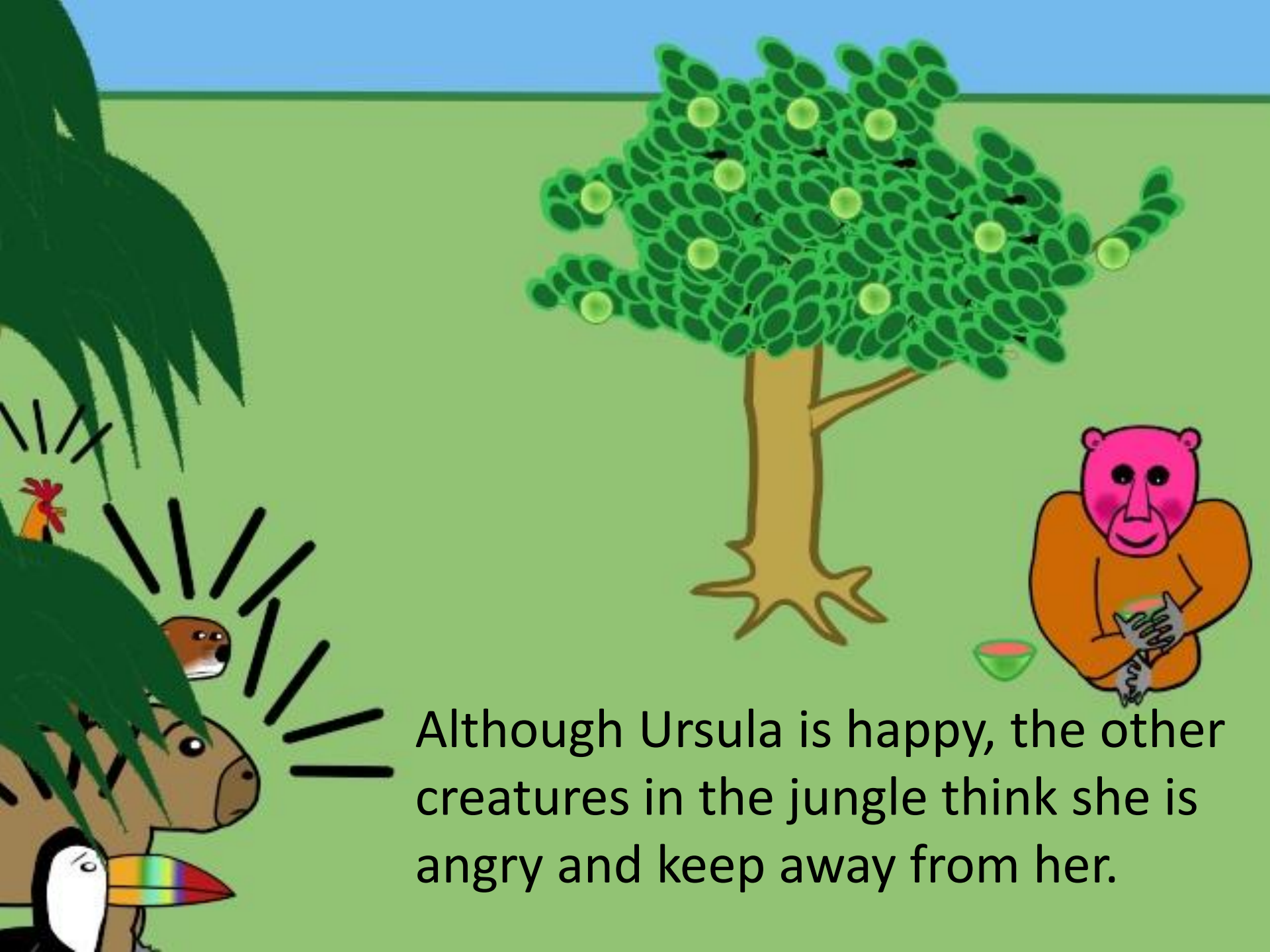


Ursula swings

search of fruit.





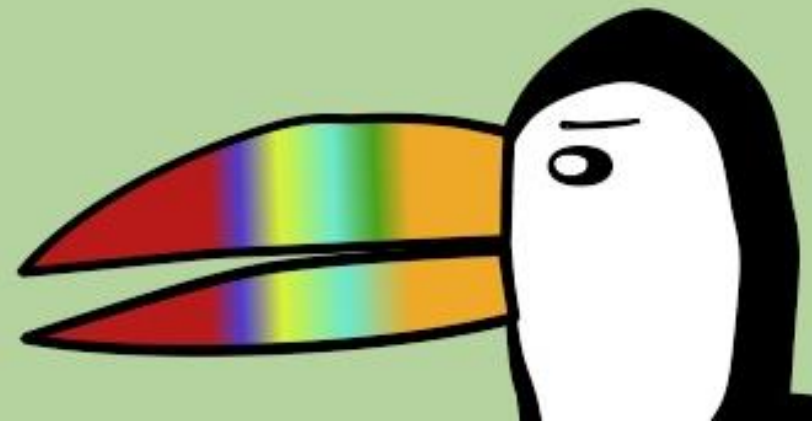
She finds a

energy.



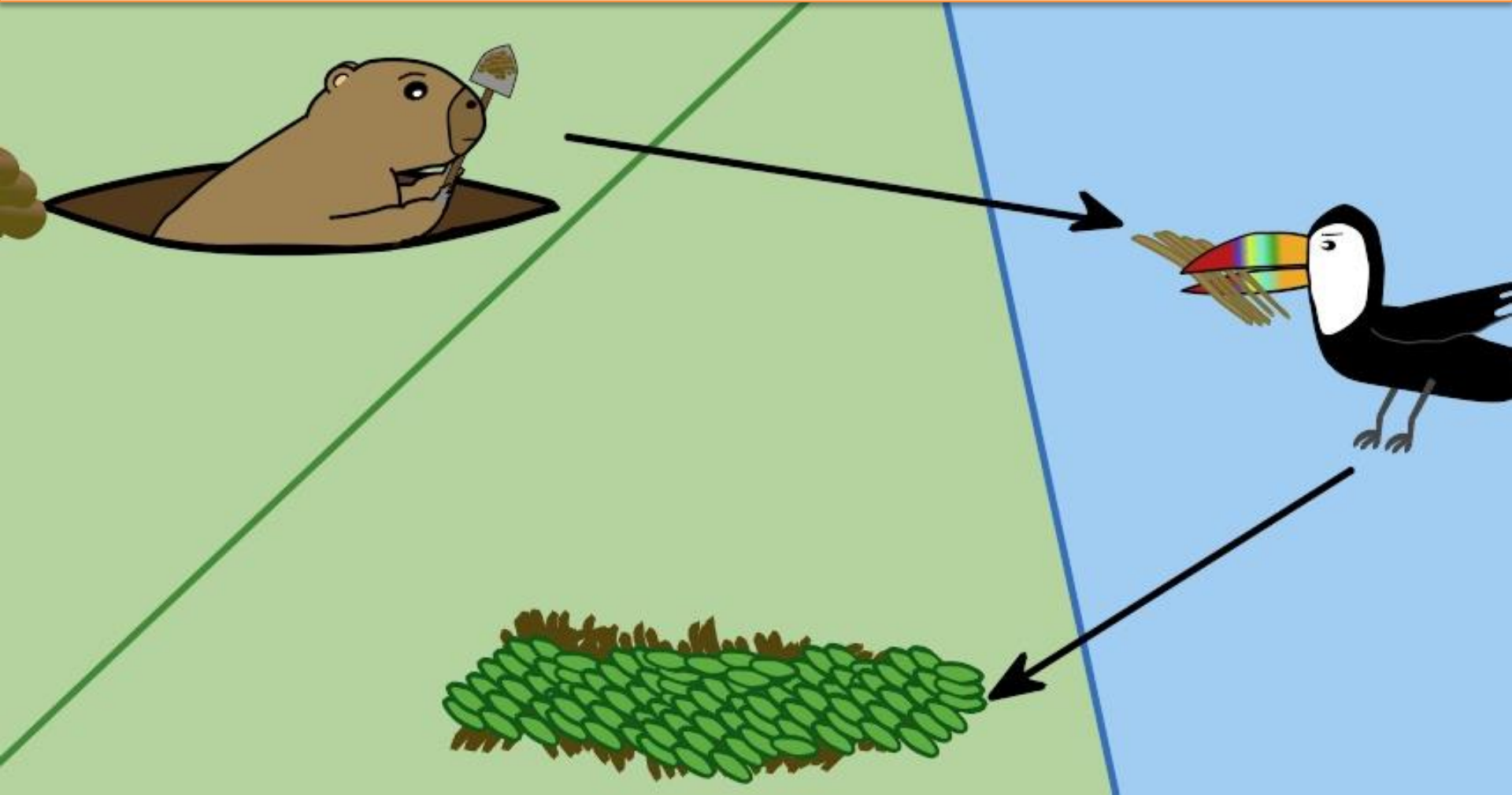
Although Ursula is happy, the other creatures in the jungle think she is angry and keep away from her.

“Safe from what?” asked Ursula.

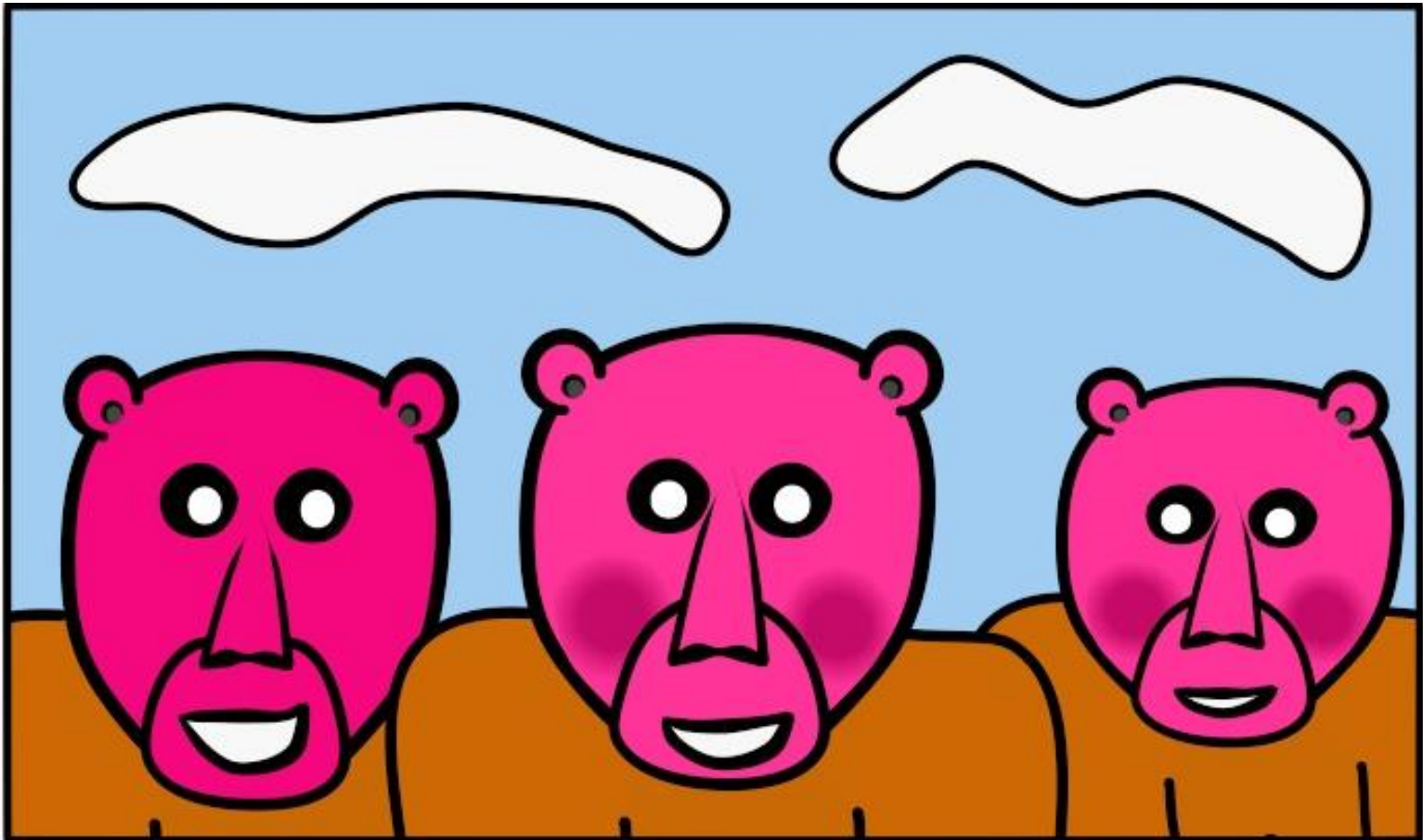
“From you angry Ursula” answered Carlos.
